Social Welfare Department runs 7 free coaching centres in six districts (total strength 1300 seats) for poor and meritorious students of SC,ST & OBC categories, those who are preparing for civil services. The Portal launched on 26th October 2017 at Kalyan Bhawan, Lucknow. On this occasion the Hon'ble Minister felicitated with Certificate of Merit to NIC UP team for IT innovation and outstanding contribution in implementing high priority projects including Post Matric Scholarship & Fee reimbursement system, Pre Matric (Class 9-10) Scholarship, Integrated Social Pension Scheme and National Family Benefit Scheme of Social Sector in Uttar Pradesh.
